Zoos

A zoo, also known as a zoological park or zoological garden, is a place where animals are confined within enclosures* for the public to view. There are currently over 1,000 large animal collections open to the public—80% of them in major cities.

Zoos give people an opportunity to observe animals they would never otherwise* get to see. In many zoos the animals are also studied and bred.* There are zoos all over the world, but the first zoo was called the Ménagerie du Jardin des Plantes and was founded in Paris in 1794. London founded the Zoological Society of London in 1828 and the name was abbreviated to "zoo." "Zoological" comes from the word "zoology," the study of animals. The first public zoo in the United States was in New York and it was called the Central Park Zoo.

Today, zoos are trying hard to keep animals in enclosures that replicate their natural habitat. The animals seem to be much better off in this type of environment and the visitors enjoy seeing the animals in a natural setting.

Nowadays, zoos throughout the world are trying to coordinate efforts to breed endangered species. The information they are learning about these animals will help zoologists preserve the species in the wild.

Although zoos have detractors, it is obvious that they do a very important task because they care for, study and protect animals, especially those that are particularly vulnerable.
