Please answer the following questions in English. (Please do not copy text but rather answer in your own words; your answers should be between 40 and 60 words in length.)

9. What is different about the recent study on myopia in comparison with what scientists used to believe?

The text states that a recent study shows that becoming myopic is unrelated to the amount of near-work (e.g. reading, looking at screens) children do. Scientists have long believed the opposite: too much near-work is detrimental to the development of your eyes. The answer should state what scientists have believed for a long time, and what the recent study shows.

10. Do you think children should play more outside and play fewer video games? Are video games bad for our eyes? What does the study described in the text suggest?

The study suggests that playing video games is unrelated to the development of myopia. People can express whatever opinion they want in relation to children playing video games; what's important is the grammar and vocabulary.
